In combining the services of these two legendary Jerusalem institutions under one name, Shaare Zedek, we are now positioned to even further extend our commitment to providing superior medical care to the people of our city and country. Both hospitals have celebrated histories charting the modern development of Jerusalem and this agreement will ensure that the services of these institutions will continue to be offered to all those in need and preserve the legacy that has defined Bikur Cholim for so many generations.

A Medical Center on the Rise

Shaare Zedek today is in fact Jerusalem's fastest growing hospital, experiencing patient increases in nearly every medical department. In key areas, such as emergency medicine, which serves as the funnel for patients to all other departments, we are the city's most active provider of urgent care. In 2012, the staff of our emergency room treated over 114,000 cases (an 8 percent increase over the prior year.)

As indicated, similar growth can be seen throughout the hospital.

In the area of maternity deliveries, Shaare Zedek exceeded 15,000 deliveries for the first time ever, with the last baby born just minutes before the strike of midnight on December 31st being delivery number 15,054 accounting for 15,361 babies.

Shaare Zedek Medical Center is now responsible for 21,000 births a year, with 15,000 births at Shaare Zedek and 6,000 at the Bikur Cholim campus.

Shaare Zedek also expanded its number of patient beds to 800 and saw 66,000 inpatient admissions leading to 298,000

hospitalization days (reflecting a 7 percent increase over the year prior.)

23,100 surgeries were performed while the hospital maintained its average length of stay for patients in all areas at 3.9 days.

The outpatient activities increased at an even steeper rate with 278,000 patients treated in relation to 241,000 in 2011 (an increase of 15.3 percent).

The hospital expanded its workforce in all relevant areas including new hires of physicians, nurses, paramedical staff and among the administration and maintenance staff. Prior to the merger with Bikur Cholim 2,495 people were employed by Shaare Zedek with several hundred more to be added as a result of the agreement.
